

God's promises


A son: "I will make of you a great nation" (12:2)

A blessing: for Abraham and for all the families of the earth (12:2–3)

A land: for his descendants forever (12:7)

GENESIS 15:18

On that day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, "To your offspring I give this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the river Euphrates."





Is the covenant fulfilled?

A son: Isaac was born

A blessing: the Messiah, Jesus Christ

A land for his descendants from the Nile River to the Euphrates

Unconditional




A son, a blessing, and a land



Still unfulfilled

The OT is the story of the *land promised* by God to the descendents of Abraham

I will give this land to your descendents forever.





With whom?

Who is "you"?

The LORD with the people he brought out of Egypt (Exodus 20:2)

With the nation of Israel (Deuteronomy 5:2)


Mediated through Moses



Conditional?

I brought you up out of Egypt. Now I am your God and you are my people. If you obey me, I will bless you. If you rebel against me, I will punish you.









Conditional or unconditional?

This covenant is very similar to treaties between nations of that time, called suzerain-vassal treaties.

CONDITIONAL



God's promises

Jehovah was their God, and Israel was his people.

If Israel obeyed God's law, he would bless them.

If Israel disobeyed God's law, he would curse them.



Is the covenant fulfilled?

The OT is the record of God's faithfulness to his covenant with Israel.

When Israel obeyed, they received blessing from God. When they rebelled against him, he punished them.

- Jehovah with the nation of Israel
- Conditional
- Blessings for obedience to the law
- Fulfilled


- God was establishing a kingdom in the land promised to Abraham with his people Israel.

EXODUS 20:12


Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long in the land that the LORD your God is giving you.


The OT is the story of the nation of Israel, the people of God.

With whom?

The LORD with king David
With the son of David—Solomon (v. 12)
With David's dynasty forever (v. 16)



God's promises

A dynasty of kings from David's sons (v. 12)

The steadfast love of the LORD (vv. 14–15)

A kingdom and a throne forever (v. 16)



Is the covenant fulfilled?

David's son, Solomon, reigned after David's death

The kings of Judah were David's sons
There is currently no king on David's throne

- The LORD with king David and his sons
- Unconditional
- A kingdom and a throne forever
- Still unfulfilled.





OLD TESTAMENT COVENANTS




God was establishing a kingdom in the land promised to Abraham with his people Israel ruled by a Davidic king.



ROMANS 11:1, 11

¹I ask, then, has God rejected his people? By no means! For I myself am an Israelite, a descendant of Abraham, a member of the tribe of Benjamin.

¹¹ So I ask, did they stumble in order that they might fall? By no means! Rather, through their trespass salvation has come to the Gentiles, so as to make Israel jealous.

With whom?

The LORD with his people Israel

- Reunited (the houses of Israel and Judah)
- Regenerated (they will all know God)
- Restored (in the promised land)



Conditional or unconditional?

Since the covenant has no conditions, it is a promise



God's promises

Resurrect Israel and reunite it with Judah Restore His people Israel to the promised land Regenerate all Israel



Is the covenant fulfilled?

The ten northern tribes—Israel—were annihilated by the Assyrians (722 B.C.) Israel is not occupying the promised land The nation of Israel are not all regenerate



How can this covenant be fulfilled?

Jesus inaugurated this covenant with his death.

Now God is extending mercy to Gentiles,
however, at the end of this age of grace, he will
restore the nation of Israel.

MATTHEW 26:27–28

And he took a cup, and when he had given thanks he gave it to them, saying, "Drink of it, all of you, for this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.

ROMANS 11:25–27

²⁵ Lest you be wise in your own sight, I do not want you to be unaware of this mystery, brothers: a partial hardening has come upon Israel, until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in. ²⁶ And in this way all Israel will be saved, as it is written,

"The Deliverer will come from Zion, he will banish ungodliness from Jacob"; (cf. Isaiah 59:20)

²⁷ "and this will be my covenant with them when I take away their sins" (cf. Jeremiah 31:33–34).





"in Christ"

How do we participate in the New Covenant? We are Gentiles, we are not part of the nation of Israel.

Our only source of blessing is found in Jesus Christ.

EPHESIANS 1:3

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places...

- The LORD with a restored and reunited Israel
- Unconditional
- Restoration, forgiveness, regenerate hearts
- Still unfulfilled

- God will establish a kingdom in the land promised to Abraham with his people Israel restored and reunited under King Jesus the son of David.
- In this age, Gentiles are receiving God's mercy through faith in Jesus Christ.
- We are expecting Jesus' coming to the earth to establish his kingdom and fulfill God's promises.

MATTHEW 6:10

Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

The New Covenant gives us the expectation of the fulfillment of all God's promises.

JEREMIAH 23:5–6

Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land. In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell securely. And this is the name by which he will be called: 'The LORD is our righteousness.'
