A. You will have a dynasty.

B. Your eternal heir will be my son.

Only the eternal God with unlimited power could make a forever promise.

III. OUR HOLY PREOCCUPATION.

A. To delight in God’s promise, not just our service.

B. To love and receive God’s denials and leading.

C. To rejoice in the grace that brings salvation.
