I. WHY DAVID DANCED.

- A. He truly delighted in his Lord.

- B. He refused to serve God half-heartedly.

II. WHY MICHAL DESPISED HIM FOR IT.

- A. She did not share his delight in the Lord. (vv. 14-15)

- B. She did not respect him as her lord. (vv. 16-20)

III. WHY THIS SHOULD MAKE A DIFFERENCE TO EVERY BELIEVER.

- A. Because we should love Christ more every day in view of the blessings bestowed on us through Calvary.

- B. Because we need to be determined that God’s view of us is more important than possible disapproval of others.

- C. Because we all should actively, enthusiastically, and reverently participate in corporate worship of the Almighty.

- D. Because we should value identification with our Savior much more precious than any worldly acceptance or acclaim.
