## "None Like You"

David's response to God's great grace is one of humble praise. His focus is not on what God needs, but on who God is!

## I. WITH GREATNESS THAT MAKES US SMALL. (vv. 18-22)

- A. When we see him as Lord, we see ourselves as servants.
- B. When we acknowledge him as Giver, the gift means so much more.

## II. WITH GREAT ACTS TO THE UNDESERVING. (vv. 23-25)

- A. All God's past blessings were by his grace and power.
- B. All God's future blessings are greater by comparison.

## III. WITH A GREAT TESTIMONY THAT LASTS FOREVER. (vv. 26-29)

Do we live in the light of the fact that "There is none like you" (v. 22) and joyfully sing to him "You are God and your words are true" (V. 28)?
