II. WITH GREAT ACTS TO THE UNDESERVING. (vv. 23-25)

- A. All God’s past blessings were by his grace and power.

- B. All God’s future blessings are greater by comparison.

III. WITH A GREAT TESTIMONY THAT LASTS FOREVER. (vv. 26-29)

Do we live in the light of the fact that “There is none like you” (v. 22) and joyfully sing to him “You are God and your words are true” (V. 28)?
