I. What Is Broken (Rom 8:19-22)?

- Disease and death are all around us.
- B. Crime, immorality, and war aren't going away.

II. How Did Creation Get This Way?

A. The Fall of man subjected creation to the curse.

Creation was subjected to futility by the sin of mankind in the garden (Gen 3:1–19).

B. The creation awaits the Creator-Sustainer's redemptive plan for it.
