

## “Two Kinds of Faith”

Faith is both a gift from God and a responsibility of the believer. Faith is not a good intention but a spiritual action.

### I. FAITH THAT \_\_\_\_\_.

#### A. A sense of \_\_\_\_\_. (vv. 22-24)

What Jesus “*saw*” was not an out-of-control situation, but an opportunity to demonstrate his authority to his disciples.

#### B. A sensation of \_\_\_\_\_. (vv. 25-27)

##### 1. Those losing heart heard, “\_\_\_\_\_”

- *Peace is the result of trusting Christ in a storm, not the result of being taken out of a storm.*

##### 2. Those who followed Jesus heard, “\_\_\_\_\_”

Nothing consoles and cheers like Christ!

#### C. A sentence of \_\_\_\_\_. (vv. 28-33)

Our “little faith” causes us to pay more attention to the sights and sounds of adversity than to the voice of the Master.

### CONCLUSION:

Weak faith wavers when it should stand. The Christian is to persevere in faith and faithfulness.
